The European Clusters Alliance (ECA) is delighted to announce the Call for Expression of Interest to host the 1st ECA Conference in December 2025. This flagship event will mark the beginning of tradition, aimed at bringing together national cluster associations, cluster members, policymakers, and industry stakeholders to reflect on achievements, strengthen collaboration, and shape the future of Europe's cluster ecosystem.

The first edition of the ECA Conference will also be a special occasion to celebrate ECA's 5th birthday, creating both a professional milestone and a celebratory moment for the community. Taking place during the festive season, this event will embrace the Christmas spirit of the host city, offering incredible opportunities for social networking amidst the charm of Christmas markets.

Key Components of the Proposal

Why Host This Event?

- Engage Stakeholders: Demonstrate your contributions to cluster development and policy alignment.
- Shape the Programme: Influence the themes, discussions, and overall direction of the event.



- Strengthen Networks: Build relationships with cluster leaders, policymakers, and international stakeholders.
- Timing: The conference is scheduled for the 1st or 2nd week of December 2025, providing a festive atmosphere to complement the event.

What We're Looking For in a Hosting Partner

- Eligibility: Open to ECA Members and Regional or National Authorities working closely with national cluster actors.
- Capacity: Accessible venues for plenary sessions, breakout discussions, and networking activities.
- o **Engagement:** A strong record of collaboration with local clusters, businesses, and authorities.
- o **Innovation:** Highlighting local or regional initiatives supporting cluster development.
- Sustainability: Integration of eco-friendly practices. Host organisation or alliances may consider financial support from sponsors and partnering organisations to strengthen event sustainability.
- Flexibility: A willingness to collaborate with ECA on the event's structure and themes.

Indicative Participation Fees structure

While the primary objective of the conference is not to generate profit, a **small delegate fee** will contribute to the financial **sustainability of the event**, help cover costs and prevent no-shows and control food waste. The following fee categories can be considered:

Cluster Representatives	For representatives of clusters that are members of national cluster associations or networks.		
Group Discount (3 Representatives)	Reduced rate for groups of three representatives from the same cluster organisation.		
Other Participants	Standard rates for participants not part of the above categories.		
Early Bird and Standard Fees	Differentiated rates to incentivise early registration.

- 1. **Motivation:** Why your organisation is the ideal host.
- 2. Ideas: Suggestions for themes, discussions, and programme highlights.
- 3. **Social and Thematic Visits:** Proposed networking and social events and visits to local innovation ecosystems.
- 4. **Fee Structure and Accommodation Options:** Details on delegate rates and preferred accommodations.

 - o Creativity in programme suggestions and innovative ideas.
 - o Commitment to collaboration and sustainability.
- 3. **Final Announcement:** The hosting organisation will be announced by **1 March 2025**.
